

Partnership for Safe Water Program Representative Wanted in Northcentral and Western Pennsylvania

The Pennsylvania Section of the American Water Works Association (PA-AWWA) is seeking a representative for the Partnership for Safe Water program (PfSW). The PfSW focuses on optimizing the operation of water systems and is supported by both the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the Section. The representative will visit water systems in Northcentral and Western Pennsylvania. The representative's primary objective will be to provide technical assistance and training (e.g. report writing and computer software) to systems working through the Partnership's Phase III and IV Self-Assessment process. A secondary objective would be to educate the owners/operators of the benefits of membership in the Partnership, with a goal of enrolling additional water systems in the program. This is a compensated and part-time position.
