

The Williamsport Municipal Water Authority and Williamsport Sanitary Authority has an immediate opening for the following managerial position:

DIRECTOR OF WASTEWATER SERVICES

Under the direction of the Director of Operations, this Senior Management position will be responsible for the Authority's two wastewater treatment facilities, which serve eight municipalities in the Greater Williamsport area. The position is responsible for all aspects of wastewater treatment operations, including administrative, supervisory, and technical services. A minimum four-year degree in a relevant technical field of study is required, with at least five years of experience in wastewater management and a comprehensive understanding of activated sludge treatment processes. A Pennsylvania Class A wastewater system certification and a valid PA driver's license are also required.

DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

Reporting directly to the Executive Director, the Director of Finance is responsible for all financial and administrative services of the Authorities, including accounting/controller and financial reporting functions, billing services and data management, funding opportunities and investments. The position involves hands-on financial and administrative duties, oversight of office operations, and interaction with Authority Board members and community leaders. A bachelor's degree with at least seven years of progressive management experience in finance or accounting is required.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT

The successful applicant for this position will assist the plant Superintendent in the supervision and maintenance of one the Authority's wastewater treatment plants. Typical tasks include the assignment and review of duties to plant personnel, staffing recommendations, record keeping, safety programs, purchasing, and overall monitoring of plant performance. The ideal candidate will possess a minimum two-year technical degree and five-years of wastewater treatment plant experience, knowledge of environmental regulations, process understanding, supervisory experience, and effective computer and communication skills. PaDEP Class A operator's certificate and a Pennsylvania driver's license are requirements of the position.
