MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY OF WESTMORELAND COUNTY CHALLENGES WATER AUTHORITIES
MAWC Donates 4,000 Gallons of Water for Haiti Relief

The Municipal Authority of Westmoreland County is donating 4,000 gallons of water to the relief efforts in Haiti. MAWC is working with the Convoy of Hope organization in their Haiti relief effort. The water produced from their George R. Sweeney treatment plant is being packaged into gallon bottles by Creekside Springs LLC of Ambridge, Pennsylvania. Approximately 1,300 cases of water being shipped to Haiti will include three (3) one gallon bottles of water in each case.

“These people have lost everything, they have nothing. They have been waiting for two days now. No one is helping us. Please bring us water or people will die soon.” said Renelde Lamarque, who has opened his home yard to about 500 quake victims in the devastated Fort National neighborhood.

MAWC is asking all other water authorities and municipalities to challenge them on their donation and join them on their Haiti Relief effort.
