4.5 Contact Hours for Drinking Water Operators

Why attend this training? Every public water system that uses a chemical disinfectant or oxidant is affected by this rule. **Most systems serving populations up to 49,999 must begin compliance with the Stage 2 DBP rule on 10/1/2013.** Many of these systems need to submit a monitoring plan prior to this date. The rule also adds a new requirement called Operational Evaluations.

This training course teaches you what you need to know about the rule, including:

- Transitioning from Stage 1 to Stage 2
- The what, when, and where of sampling
- Response requirements in the event of a violation
- Operational Evaluations (new requirement!)
- Creating a monitoring plan

Who should attend? Operators and managers of community and nontransient noncommunity water systems (including consecutive systems) that use a chemical disinfectant or oxidant. ***Due to class size, we ask that each system initially registers no more than two individuals. If possible, a system should send one treatment plant and one distribution system representative responsible for decision-making in each of these areas.***
