From the South: From I-95, take the "West Chester Exit," Rte. 322 West. Follow Rte. 322 West to Rte 1; make a left onto Rte. 1 and follow approximately 3 lights. Make a right onto Rte. 202 North; continue for 15 to 20 min. to Rte. 100, "Exton Exit." Follow Rte. 100 North approximately 5 miles to Wyndham Garden on right.
